

Master Craft Theme – User Guide

Theme Installation

1. Download the *MasterCraft_1.0.2.zip* file after purchase.
2. Extract / unzip the file on your drive.
 - a. After unzipping you will see a folder named *Master Craft Theme*.
 - b. Inside this folder is a file named *mastercraft.zip*. This is the theme itself.
3. Go to your WordPress admin panel. Under the *Appearance* menu, click *Themes*.
4. Click the *Install Themes* tab and on the screen displayed, click *Upload*.
5. Click *Browse*, then navigate to the *Master Craft Theme* folder on your computer.
6. Left click the *mastercraft.zip* file, then click 'Open'.
 - a. The browse window closes, the *Install Themes* screen is re-displayed, and the file is now ready to install.
7. Click the 'Install Now' button.
 - a. The zip file is installed and the following message is displayed: 'Theme installed successfully.' You will also now see three options: *Preview* / *Activate* / *Return to Themes page*.
8. Click 'Activate'.
 - a. The *Master Craft* theme will now be visible when you view your website.

Slider / Spotlights



Content for the slider at the top of the *Master Craft* theme is drawn from the custom post type named “Spotlights”.

Posting a spotlight through the WordPress admin panel is essentially the same as posting a regular Page.

Under the *Spotlights* menu in the admin panel click *Add New* and enter any text, image or video content. When published, this content will appear in the slider.



If only a single *Spotlight* is published it will appear statically, however if multiple *Spotlights* are published a slider will be activated that rotates through each *Spotlight* as a slide.

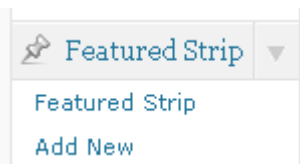
To control the order of the slides change the *Order* field, numbering from 1 onward.

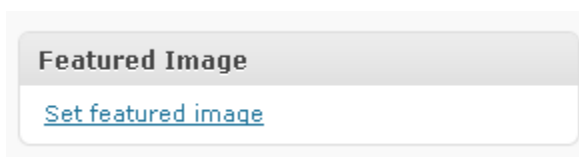
Carousel / Featured Strip



Content for the carousel beneath the slider is drawn from the custom post type named “Featured Strip”.



The actual images added to the carousel by attaching a “Featured Image” to a *Featured strip* post.



To control the order of the carousel images change the *Order* field, numbering from 1 onward.



The size of your carousel images is drawn from your site's default thumbnail size. To see the correct carousel image size in your WordPress admin panel click *Media* under the *Settings* menu.



In the thumbnail size section set *Width* to 300 and *Height* to 0. Uncheck the box marked "Crop thumbnail to exact dimensions".

Your carousel images can be any height, but they should all share the same height. In the demo of this theme the carousel images are all 118px high.

Menus

Both menus support custom menus with up to two drop down levels. Custom menus can be added to these locations under *Appearance* > *Menus* in your WordPress admin panel.

Spiderbox & Spideriframe – Colorboxes

To have an image open in a colorbox overlay, create a link to it and add `class="spiderbox"` to the link code. E.g.

```
<a href="mybigimage.jpg" class="spiderbox">My Anchor Text</a>
```

To have a website open in an iframe colorbox overlay, create a link to it and add `class="spideriframe"` to the link code. E.g.

```
<a href="http://www.mysite.com" class="spideriframe">My Anchor Text</a>
```

Customizing with the Website Weaver plugin

The *Master Craft* theme is compatible with The Website Weaver theme editing plugin, which allows you to make extensive customizations to the theme.
